FRENCH ARISTOCRAT ALEXIS CHARLES-HENRI CLEREL DE TOCQUEVILLE WAS 26 YEARS OLD WHEN HE CAME TO AMERICA IN 1831. HE WAS A KEEN OBSERVER OF AMERICAN SOCIETY, AND HE RECOGNIZED, APPLAUDED AND IMMORTALIZED THE VOLUNTARY SPIRIT THAT LIVES IN AMERICA'S HEART. HIS OBSERVATIONS FORMED THE BASIS FOR *DEMOCRACY IN AMERICA*, A BOOK DESCRIBING THIS NEW COUNTRY AND ITS PEOPLE.
